



FIFTH AVENUE COWHIDE

PRODUCT CHARACTERISTIC SHEET

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Fifth Avenue Cowhide is a lightly pigmented and waxed leather that uses proprietary glazes and topcoats that highlight the natural beauty of the leather and accentuates the subtle antiquing of each hide.

CHARACTERISTICS:

Being a natural product, Fifth Avenue Cowhide will exhibit natural characteristics such as healed scars, veins, neck wrinkles, and grain variation throughout a hide and from hide to hide.

The beauty of this color palette highlights the unique pull-up finish that is created with special oils and waxes to add depth and transparency within the hide.

Fifth Avenue Cowhide will exhibit natural variations in color, tone and texture that are part of the beauty of this leather. Each hide's unique history and natural markings, such as neck wrinkles, should be expected and will vary within a hide and from hide to hide.

As a wax pull-up leather, this product will burnish and patina with wear, showing scratches and other markings while in use.



NECK/FAT WRINKLES

A: Permanent natural creases on the hide caused by fat deposits in the live animal usually found in the neck, shoulder, and belly area.

LOOSE GRAIN

B: Loose grain is characterized by large "breaks" in the density of the grain visible on the surface of the hide. Generally-speaking, loose grain is often found towards the perimeter of a hide.

TIGHT GRAIN

C: Characteristic wherein the grain structure visible on the surface of the hide is more uniform and "tight." Tight grain is generally preferred and found more consistently towards the interior of the hide.

SCARS

D: Healed wound during life of animal which is characterized by raised surface and inconsistent grain.
